<u>Call to Order</u> – Chair Theresa Goodness called the meeting to order at Noon. - Linda shared that she was to meet with Judy Linsley concerning the status of Bill Quick's book on Sabine Pass. At the time of his death, it was

- reported to be in its final review. Les McMahen had provided several chapters and was helping with the final proofing. More information will be shared at the September meeting.
- Linda has contacted the Sam Houston Regional Library and Research Center in Liberty to see if it is possible for several JCHC members to help inventory Bill Quick's papers housed at the Library. Darlene Moss-Smart shared that due to Library renovations it is not possible at this time. She suggested waiting until spring and talk with the staff at that time.
- Linda asked Peter Kaatrude to introduce his guest Sarah Bellian from the Museum of the Gulf Coast. Sarah shared the Museum has some of Paul Tanner's archeology collection and also some of Bill Quick's photos and papers. Linda extended an invitation to Sarah to consider joining the JCHC.

Committee Reports

<u>Archeology Committee</u> – Brenda Jackson has been inventorying some information and artifacts from Paul Tanner's estate. We are very appreciative of her expertise. She will be helping to put in an exhibit in the mini-museum which will run from early September through November 1. After that time, the public will no longer have access to that area of the Courthouse due to interior renovations.

<u>History Appreciation / Film Commission – Jef Russell</u> – Jef shared about the Texas Historical Commission's Texas Treasure Business Award. This award recognizes the accomplishments of Texas businesses that have provided employment opportunities and support to the state's economy for at least 50 years. Jef had a list of local business that would qualify. He will be in touch with several to get their feedback. More will be reported at the September meeting.

<u>History Preservation – Charlotte Holliman</u> – No report

<u>Historical Markers – Les McMahen</u> – There is no activity at present. The new application period for 2015 markers is September 1 through November 15, 2014.

<u>Website Committee – Bill Cummings</u> – There have been no meetings since the May JCHC meeting. Most website elements have been developed or defined, but need to integrate the component parts and work with MIS Department to actually create the website. Bulk of the historical text has been distributed to the committee members for review and comment. Need to identify and collect images for the history portion. Particular areas of interest are cattle raising, steamboats, Civil War, lumbering, rice cultivation and processing, railroads, and early industry.
