The following corrections and clarifications are made to the plans and contract documents:

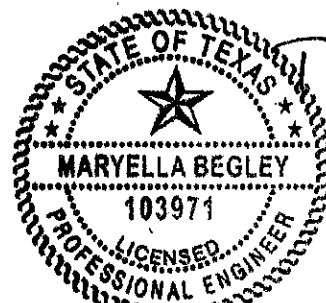
1. The Bid Proposal in the Contract Documents shall be removed and replaced with the revised Bid Proposal attached hereto.
2. In the Construction Plans, Sheet 6, the Culvert Crossing Detail called out on Sheet 33 is on Sheet 21.
3. In the Construction Plans, Sheet 7, the Spillway Detail out on Sheet 34 are on Sheet 22 and Ramp Detail called out on Sheet 35 are on Sheet 23.
4. In the Construction Plans, Sheets 8 and 9, the Drainage Swale Detail called out on Sheet 34 is on Sheet 22.
5. In the Construction Plans, Sheets 11-13, the Pipe Detail called out on Sheet 34 is on Sheet 22.
6. In the Construction Plans, Sheet 14, the Road Saw-cut Limits are 67 linear feet.
7. In the Construction Plans, Sheets 14, 15, and 21, the shown Existing (2) 24" RCP and Existing 30" RCP are to remain in place.
8. In the Construction Plans, Sheet 14, the Culvert Crossing Detail is on Sheet 21.
9. In the Construction Plans, Sheet 15, the Box Culvert Quantity is 48 linear feet.
10. In the Construction Plans, Detail "A" on Sheet 22, is hereby changed to call for 3000 psi concrete.
11. The following note shall be added to Sheets 14, 15, and 21: NOTE: Construction shall be performed so that only one half of the roadway is closed at a time. The Contractor shall be responsible for coordinating with the County.
12. For clarification, suitable excavated material may be for fill where needed. It shall be compacted to match the compaction of native materials in place or 90% Standard Proctor.

The calculation of quantities of lines at various depths will be based on the plan and profile sheets and not on measurements made in the field unless it has been determined by the Engineer that there is a discrepancy between the plan and profile sheets and the actual elevations in the field.

Bidder agrees that the work will be substantially completed and completed and ready for final payment in accordance with the General Conditions within the time limits set forth in the Agreement. Bidder accepts the provision of the Agreement as to liquidated damages in the event of failure to complete the Work within the times specified in the Agreement.
