

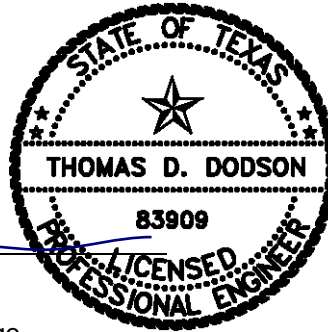

See below for responses to Bidder questions regarding the Runway 12/30 Remarketing project at Jack Brooks Regional Airport.

Question 1: Are survey nails to be set within the limits of the runway?

Answer: As noted in 50-06, layout for paint markings can be by 1.5" PK nails, but these are to be removed after painting. The airport waives the requirement that marking layout be made by setting nails.

Question 2: Is there a form for the bidder's qualifications?

Answer: A form acceptable for submitting with bid is included in Addendum No. 1.

Question 3: The quantities for the base bid appear to exceed bidder's computed quantities. Will the bid form items be recalculated?

Answer: An updated bid form is included in Addendum No. 1.

Question 4: Will water be available for use in the paint marking removal?

Answer: Hydrants are available for use. Contractor will be required to coordinate with the City of Nederland for purchase of water.

Question 5: During marking removal, will there be a location to dispose of water from the blasting?

Answer: On the condition that the water is free of paint material and not considered hazardous or noxious to vegetation, discharge of the water into the infield area(s) adjacent to the project will be permitted.

Question 6: What is the contract duration?

Answer: Contract duration is established on page C-7 of the project manual.

Question 7: In locations where paint removal is across a spalled or cracked pavement area, what will be required of repair of the spall?

Answer: Joints and cracks that are sealed, if damaged by contractor's activities, are to be repaired by the contractor as required in the plans and specifications at no additional cost to the airport. Unsealed cracks and areas of large (greater than 3/4 inch) spalls or areas that form large spalls as a result of the paint removal will be repaired by the airport prior to re-painting. The airport will work to patch areas as quickly as possible, but Contractor may be required to allow time for repairs to be made prior to repainting the affected areas.
