RFQ 14-021/KJS for Environmental Services

Jefferson County, Texas is seeking to enter into an environmental services contract with a state-registered firm for a County Transportation Infrastructure Fund Grant Program project. The following outlines this request for proposals.

I. Scope of Work - The contract will encompass all project-related environmental services to the County, including but not limited to the following:

- perfoming environmental investigation and analysis of the project site
- identification of all environmental issues
- obtaining all required permits and clearances from the appropriate regulatory agencies
- preparation of any necessary environmental documents
- other special services necessary to accomplish the project

Please specify actual tasks to be performed under each of these categories.

Major Drive Extension

This is a new-location roadway project that will extend Major Drive from SH 124 to the southeast to connect to LaBelle Road. The proposed roadway will be 2 lanes with shoulders and turning bays at the intersection with SH 124. The project is approximately 1 mile long and will impact approximately 21 acres of land.

The estimated cost of construction is \$1.4M.

II. Statement of Qualifications - The County is seeking to contract with a competent firm registered to practice in the State of Texas that has had experience in the following areas:

- wetland delineation
- nationwide/individual permits
- Coast Guard and US Army Corps of Engineers permits
- protected species determination
- environmental document preparation
- projects located in this general region of the state

As such, please provide within your proposal a list of past client local governments, as well as brief resumes of all engineers/environmentalists who will or may be assigned to this project if you receive the environmental services contract award.

Also, please provide a copy of your current certificate of insurance for professional liability.
