ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT:

- (a) Consider and possibly approve the Golden Pass LNG Terminal use of County property at Keith Lake Fish Pass according to the following:
 - 1) Keith Lake Fish Pass Cut water body for routing of dredge pipeline in manner similar to what was approved by the County for the Pintail Flats Marsh Restoration Project in 2006/2007.
 - 2) Proposed County Park located on the north side of Keith Lake Fish Pass off Highway 87. All activities and use of the site would be restricted to the County's environmental permitted footprint for the access road, parking lot and boat ramp/lagoon and boat cut.
 - 3) Southwestern 1/3 of the graveled area located on the south side of Keith Lake Fish Pass at Highway 87.

Project is located in Precinct No. 3.

SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT:

(a) Consider and possibly approve a Resolution allowing the Regional Crime Lab to apply for the 2010 Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant. This is a fully funded NIJ grant request in the amount of \$29,000, and requires no cash match from the county.

DISTRICT ATTORNEY:

(a) Request approval for Tom Maness, Criminal District Attorney, to attend the National District Attorney's Association Conference. The conference will cover the most current and pressing prosecution topics. Keynote speaker will be former Supreme Court Justice Sandra Day O'Conner. It will be held in Sacramento, California, July 11-14, 2010. This is a budgeted item and required Continuing Legal Education credits will be received. The estimated cost is \$1,600.00.
