Said meeting will be a Regular Meeting for the purpose of transacting the routine business of the County. Persons with disabilities requiring auxiliary aids for services who wish to attend this meeting should contact the County Judge's Office to arrange for assistance.

In addition to the routine business of the County, the subject of said meeting will be the following:

PURCHASING:

- a. Receive and file bids for IFB 10-023/KJS Bridge Replacement Projects: Boondocks Road at North Fork of Taylor's Bayou.
- b. Receive and file bids for IFB 10-024/KJS Bridge Replacement Projects: Humble Camp Road at Hillebrandt Bayou.
- c. Award. IFB 10-023/KJS Bridge Replacement Projects: Boondocks Road at North Fork of Taylor's Bayou to APAC-Texas, Inc. in the amount of \$452,311.95.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION CENTER:

- (a) Consider and possibly approve a Resolution for grant application by the Jefferson County Dispute Resolution Center for the Jefferson County Shared Parenting Solutions Program.

JUVENILE PROBATION DEPARTMENT:

- (a) Consider and possibly approve the application and accompanying Resolution for the Juvenile Accountability Block Grant in the amount of \$25,918 and cash match of \$2879.78. The cash match will be made using probation fees at no cost to county funds. This grant has been received for several years and is used to continue Intensive Supervision Juvenile Probation Services.

SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT:

- (a) Consider and possibly approve authorization of the Regional Crime Lab's application for the 2010 Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant. This is a fully funded NIJ grant request in the amount of \$55,000, and requires no cash match from the county.
