BE IT REMEMBERED at a meeting of Commissioners' Court of Jefferson County, Texas, held on the 20th day of July, 2015, on motion made by Everette Alfred, Commissioner of Precinct No. 4, and seconded by Eddie Arnold, Commissioner of Precinct No. 4, the following RESOLUTION was adopted:

WAIVING FILING FEES FOR JEFFERSON COUNTY RESIDENTS SUBJECT TO AN ORDER EMERGENCY DETENTION FOR MENTAL HEALTH PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, 571.018, Texas Mental Health Code provides that costs for a hearings or proceedings under this subtitle shall be paid the county that initiates emergency detention procedures or, if no emergency detention procedures are initiated, by the county that accepts an application for court-ordered mental health services, issues an order for protective custody or issues an order for temporary mental health services; and

WHEREAS, the costs referred to herein include County Clerk filing fees, attorney fees for appointed personnel and fees generally charged for filling of a civil action; and

WHEREAS, the designated mental hospitals in Jefferson County that are currently providing mental health services for patients who are detained by order of the Jefferson County Courts are desperately underfunded and a great many of those patients are indigent, to require that those hospitals pay filing costs and costs of court for mental health proceedings will result in a loss of necessary emergency treatment; and


WHEREAS, there are generally no beds available in a state-funded public mental health hospitals for treatment of persons detained on an emergency order for detention; and

WHEREAS, the local private mental hospitals in Jefferson County receive patients in need of mental health treatment from several other counties within the Spindletop Center Region which overtaxes the capacity of our hospitals and reduces the number of available beds for treatment of Jefferson County residents.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that each hospital in Jefferson County, Texas that provides mental health services to a person who is ordered by the Courts of Jefferson County to be detained for psychiatric evaluation and/or treatment shall not be required to pay filling fees or court costs assessed by the County Clerk of Jefferson County, Texas for such filings.

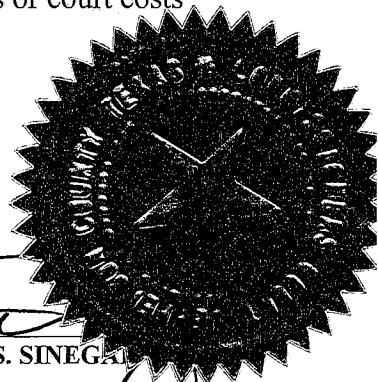
