1 JUDGE DOLLINGER: I guess we'll go ahead and

21 Applications to become bondsmen or agents and
22 renewals of same.

25 here but it was -- it was given to me because Becky is out today

1 and the only thing that was brought to my attention was about
2 the insurance on one of the properties for Erika Francois and I
3 had gotten with Erika and everything is in order. The insurance
4 was reissued and we were added as additional interest on the
5 insurance, the County was. So it all seems to be in order as
6 far as I can tell.

7 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Okay. Do I have a motion to
8 approve Ms. Francois' application for renewal?

9 JUDGE WEST: So moved.

10 JUDGE DOLLINGER: I have a motion.

24 or questions on the treasurer's report? Okay.

25 Auditor's office, am I correct we did not get a

1 report from the auditor's office this time?

2 MS. BENOIT: We did not.

3 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Okay. So we can't do that.

4 Are there any properties, CDs, cashier's checks requested to be
5 released?

6 MS. BENOIT: No, sir.

7 JUDGE DOLLINGER: None. Okay. I think that
8 concludes the items on the agenda. Does anyone have any
9 business that was held over from last month that needs to be
10 addressed at this month's meeting?

11 Hearing none. Then I'll call for a motion to
12 adjourn.

13 MS. GOODNESS: So moved.

14 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Motion to adjourn. All those
