1 JUDGE WEST: All right. Thank you all for being
2 here.

1 JUDGE WEST: Perfect. All right. Any
2 applications for new agents or renewals?

3 MS. BERTRAND: No, ma'am.

4 JUDGE WEST: Any complaints?

5 MS. HOLMES: No, ma'am.

6 JUDGE WEST: Report from the treasurer, everybody
7 should've received that, as well. Any discussions or questions
8 or concerns?

9 MR. HALLMARK: Nothing to report.

10 JUDGE WEST: Any requests for release of
11 property, CDs, cash, cashier's checks?

12 MS. HOLMES: No. Glenda said no.

13 JUDGE WEST: Report from the auditor's office,
14 everyone should've received that, as well, I believe.

1 late.

2 MS. BERTRAND: Yes.

3 JUDGE WEST: So, it really has only been three
4 weeks.

5 MS. BERTRAND: Yes.

6 JUDGE WEST: And I've been in trial two of those.
7 So, that's why it seems fast. We're working on it. I did get
8 with him this week about modifying those bond conditions.

9 (MR. ROEBUCK ENTERS THE HEARING.)

10 JUDGE WEST: I thought you weren't going to be
11 here.

12 MR. ROEBUCK: Well, I got out.

13 JUDGE WEST: Anyway, the plan is to change the
14 bond conditions to reflect what I believe is proper which is you
15 cannot -- it's almost like a preset bond is what they told us at
16 our conference with regard to the drug patches and the things
17 that we added. We just haven't done it yet. His jury is out.
18 Hopefully they're about to get a break and I'll be able to visit
19 with him and we can get that done, but it hasn't been done yet.
20 So, technically we still have the bond conditions but it
21 shouldn't be much longer and those will get changed.

22 And that's kind of it. Does anybody have any
23 other business that we need to talk about?

24 (NO RESPONSE.)

25 JUDGE WEST: Is there a motion to adjourn?

1 JUDGE JONES: So moved.

2 JUDGE LIVELY: Second.

3 JUDGE WEST: Done. Look at that, y'all.

4 MS. HOLMES: That was a record.

5 JUDGE WEST: 3 minutes.
