The current offenses that they are in custody for will show up. If there is a bond amount set that amount shows up. And if there was additional conditions, those are showing up. The standards won't obviously because they're standards. But any additional bond conditions are showing up.

JUDGE WEST: Okay.

MS. BERTRAND: If there is a blank, on the second page that I gave y'all, there is a blank on the charge for murder and forgery. One of two things happens. The case is so old -- like in this instance, the case was so old there was a bond amount set for both of these. But that's before we went live. So it's not going to carry over. But according to the new standards in the Senate Bill 6, they would have to be remagistrated anyway and then go before the magistrate. But other than that, you should see a bond amount if one is set.
