The one thing that was an issue that I've worked on is the time period between a case being filed and indicted and those bond conditions that are put on by the magistrates out at the jail that no one is really monitoring -- or they're monitoring but they -- we had an issue whether or not Judge Derouen had the authority to issue warrants if there was violation of those bond conditions. So I talked to Judge Derouen. We've talked to some different counties, and I've done a little research. We think that he can issue those I don't think that's an issue. warrants. So then I talked to Mary Helm about how to actually make it where he can do that, which of course is not as easy as us just saying we say he can do so have him do it. She used some words -- I don't know -- pods or some kind of something that each division has. He doesn't have one of those. And so there is a couple of things she's looking into.
