6 JUDGE WOODS: Okay. Any other business that  
7 hasn't been covered that we need to cover? Any new? Old?  
8 Nothing? Hearing none --

9 CAPTAIN MORRIS: I got something.

4 CAPTAIN MORRIS: It's the Jefferson County  
5 Sheriff's Office.

6 MS. HOLMES: It looks like that (indicating).

7 JUDGE WOODS: Okay. Awesome.

8 MS. SEGURA: Okay.

9 JUDGE WOODS: I can just say this. Mitch Woods
