COURSE OBJECTIVE:

This course is designed to provide the basic concepts of instruction and to increase the quality of professional law enforcement training.

PRE-REQUISITES:

To qualify, an applicant for an instructor proficiency certificate must meet all proficiency requirements, and must have:

- (1) substantial experience in teaching or in the special field or subject area to be taught, to include:
 - (A) two years' experience as a peace officer, telecommunicator, jailer; or
 - (B) a bachelor's degree and two years of teaching experience; or
 - (C) a graduate degree;
- (2) successfully completed an instructor training course or its equivalent, as determined by the executive director.

OVERVIEW:

This course introduces the student to the teaching-learning process, phases of the teaching-learning process, factors affecting learning, preparing a lesson plan, and methods of instruction. The students will be taught how to develop and use instructional media to enhance their presentations. Each trainee must demonstrate the basic knowledge and skills required to effectively instruct a lesson during two teaching exercises which will be evaluated by two instructors.
